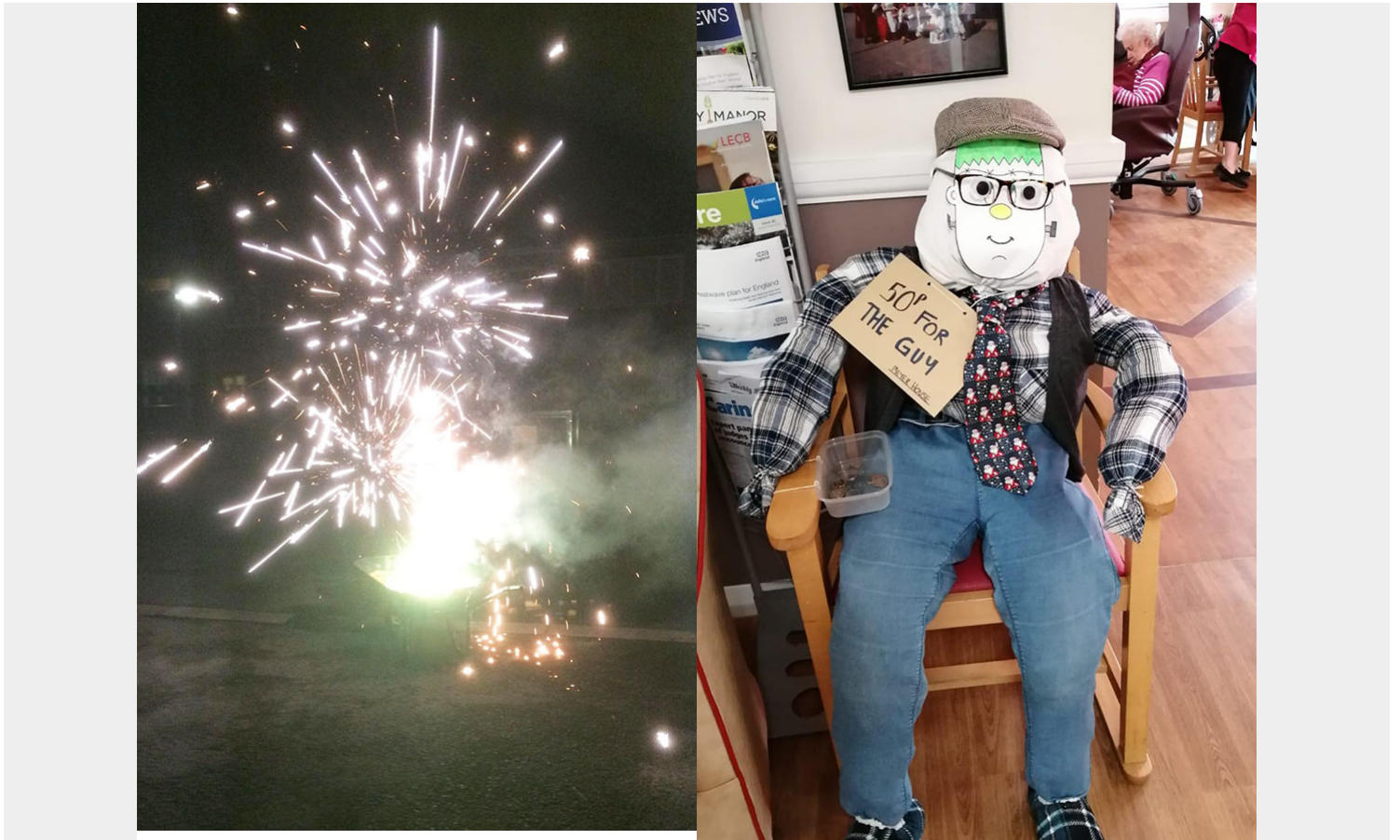


Meyer House Care Home celebrates fireworks night
