Dear Residents,

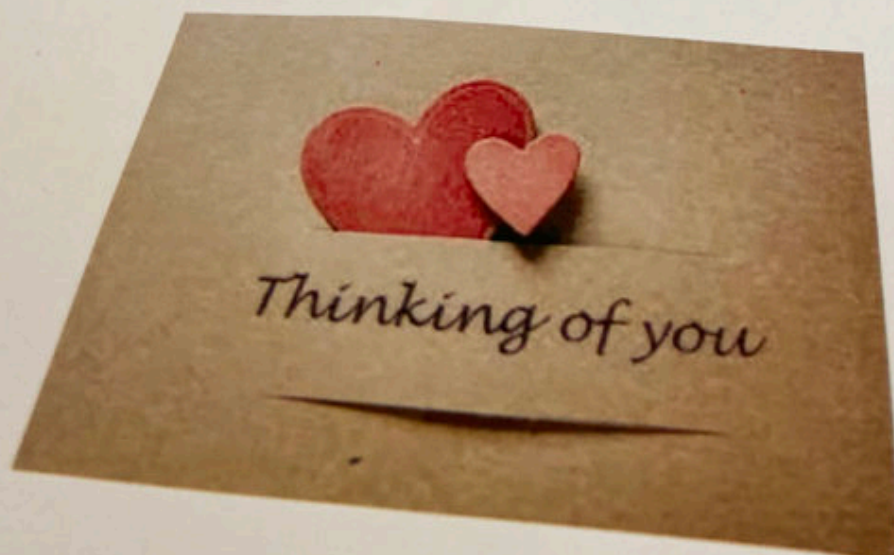
